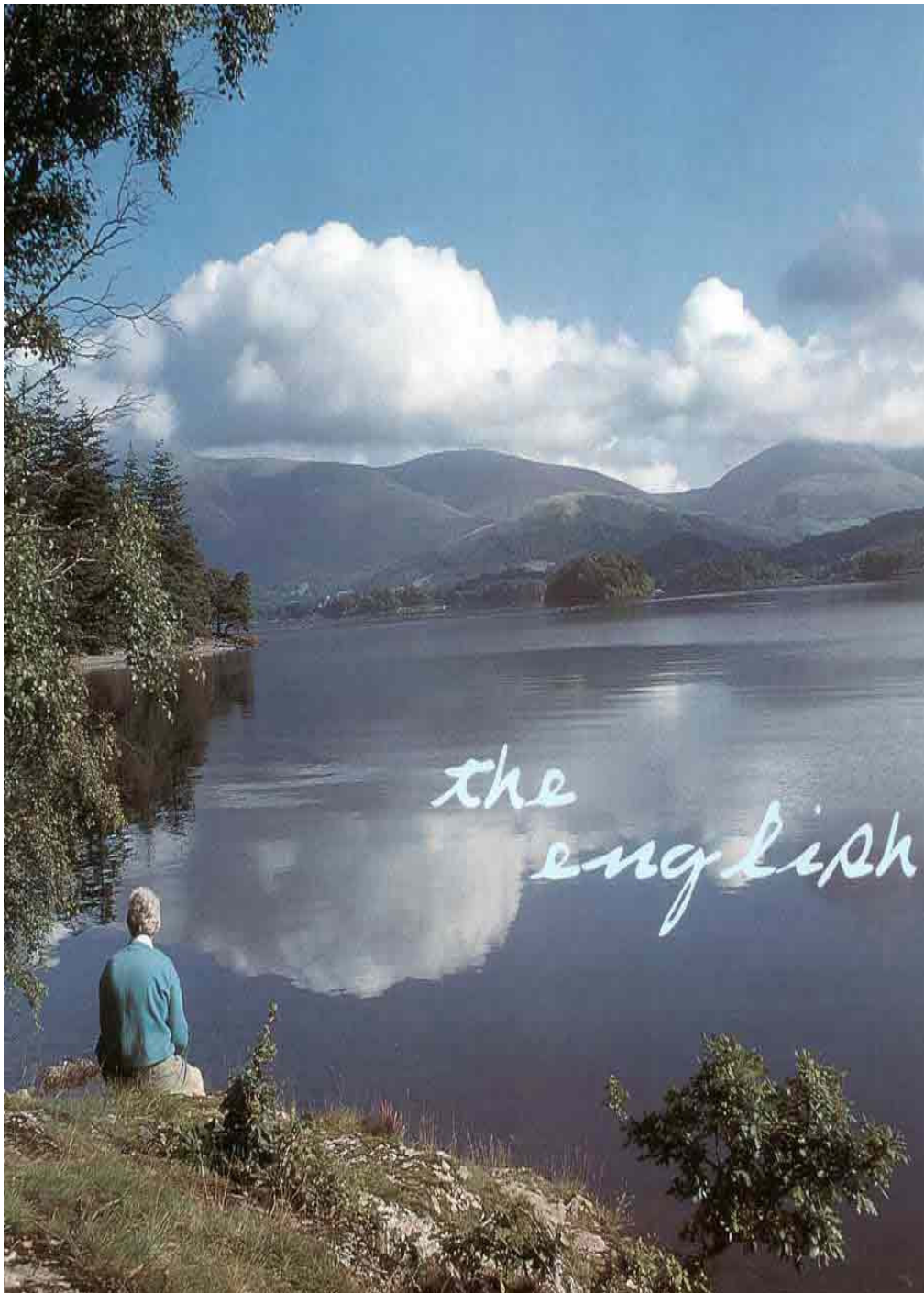


Dale Head Hall Lakeside Hotel

On the death of Thomas Stanger-Leathes, Manchester Corporation bought the hall and lake to provide Victorian Manchester with clean drinking water and successive Lord Mayors with an idyllic summer retreat. Since 1990, the resident proprietors have lovingly restored the Hall and gardens, into one of Lakeland's finest country house hotels.

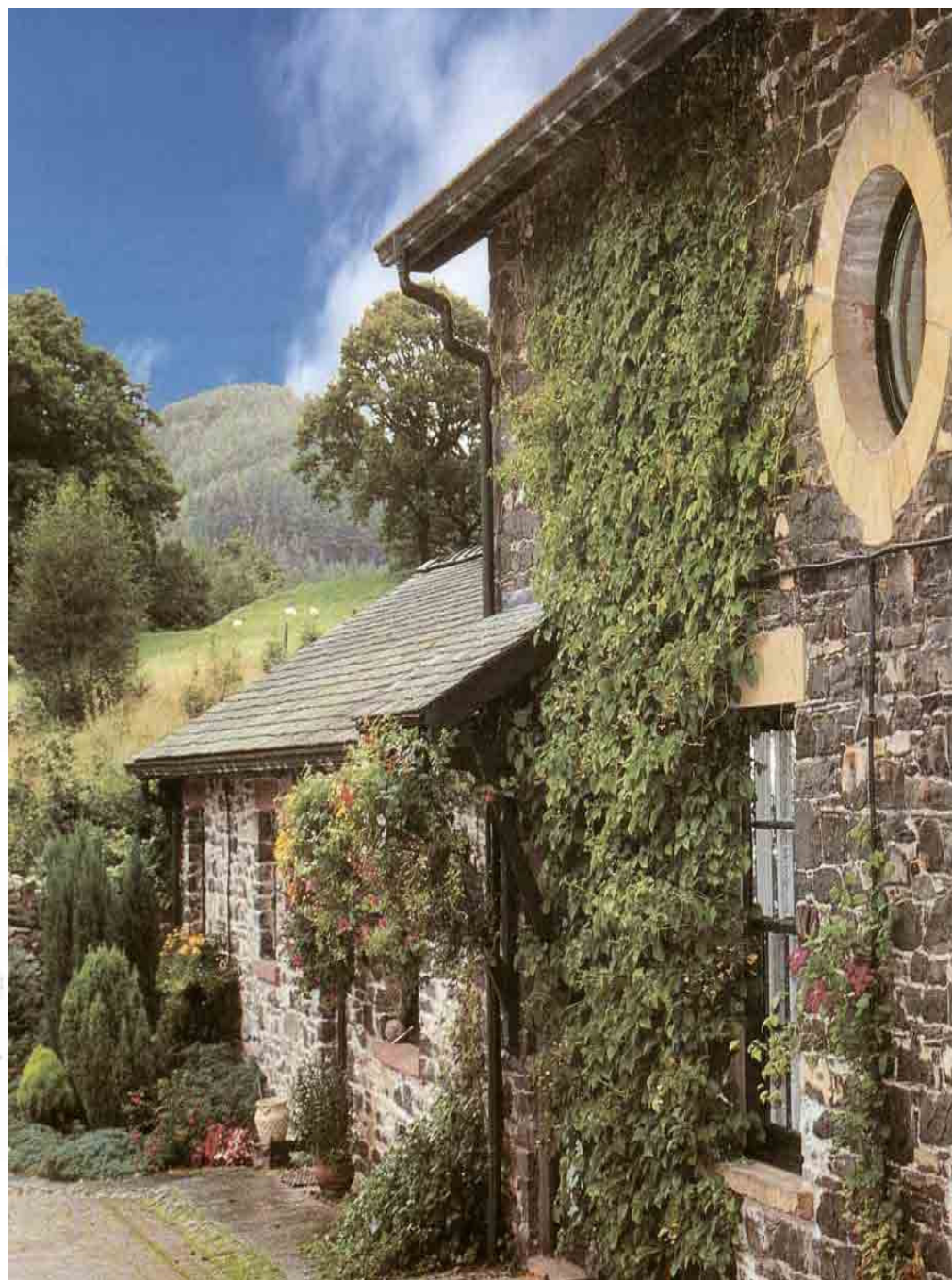




the Victorian coach house
